Hope you guys are safe and healthy. EPA has reviewed the Seneca Army Depot OB Grounds 2019 LTM Report. We have one comment on the Report.

An alternative recommendation made in the report is that in the future, the cap and creek inspections would be performed as part of the annual SEDA LUC inspections, and that groundwater sampling at the OB Grounds would be performed every 5 years at the time of the 5-year review. EPA agrees with this recommendation, with the clarification that the cap and creek inspections and groundwater monitoring are still requirements of the OB Grounds ROD. If the Army wishes to do away with the inspections, groundwater monitoring, and groundwater restriction, then an additional decision document such as an ESD would be required.
